What is a Co-op?

A co-op preschool provides an opportunity for parents to actively participate in the classroom with their children. Under the supervision of a qualified teacher, the children can move toward independence in their early educational experience. Parents act as teacher's aides, maintain the classroom, & assist in the preparation of daily materials and activities.

As a parent, your involvement is vital to the successful operation of the preschool. Parent involvement includes:

- Attend parent meeting at beginning of year
- Assist in classroom 1-3 times a month
- Provide snacks for class 1-2 times per month
- Attend field trips with your child

NON co-op options are available, but space is limited!!



Health Requirements

Once enrolled, parents will receive an information packet in early August. The packet will include helpful information and a few forms that are needed by the first day of school such as a physician signed health appraisal and immunization records. An informational meeting for all parents will be held in late August.
